

EDITOR'S NOTES

Events of the past year continue to resonate through Thanet cricket and our major casualty has been the loss of the Yearbook. Thus this booklet contains but brief details of the 2007 season together with the fixtures for 2008. Hopefully with the League's finances on the road to recovery normal service can be resumed in 2009. In the meantime the committee will be looking at the possibility of setting up a web-site which would allow clubs to print off their own fixtures.

48 teams took part in 2007 although a last minute withdrawal meant that Division Four had only seven sides while Division Six had nine. Four of the six Divisional winners completed their season with a 100% record the first occasion that this has occurred. A reduced number of teams meant that we were able to re-introduce the K.O. Cup for the first time since 1998. Teams entered on a voluntary basis and the format involved a successful handicap system. It was won in fine style by Dane Court.

There was a welcome reduction in the number of occasions when teams played short, down to 42 the lowest since the 2000 season, but some teams particularly in Division Six were plainly overstretched.

Thirty individual scores in excess of fifty were recorded a slight decrease from 2006 (33). There was another fall in the number of occasions three or more wickets were taken in an innings down to 61 the lowest since 1984.

Darren Cousins of Hartsdonians B won the Jarman Trophy with 403 runs, his margin of 34 over second place John Haddock was identical to last year's winner. Chris Norris with seventeen wickets gained the Fred Roberts Trophy just one ahead of Andy Chapman, Ray Keatley & Dave Little.

For only the second time in the League's history there were no new Divisional partnership records

There was just one partnership in excess of 50 for both the 5th & 6th wicket. In Divisions Six & the K.O Cup respectively.

Andy Marshall & Keith Sandwell become the 8th & 9th batsmen to pass the 7,000 run mark while three bowlers Ian Robinson, Bobby Spence and Alan Winch reached 200 wickets bringing that total to 22..

In the Double section a further six players reached the first stage, 1000 runs and 50 wickets bringing the total to 261 while Gary Impett and Bob Spence were two additions to the 5,000 runs & 150 wickets section bringing that total to seventeen..

The decrease in the number of teams was reflected in the total who played down from 568 to 516.
